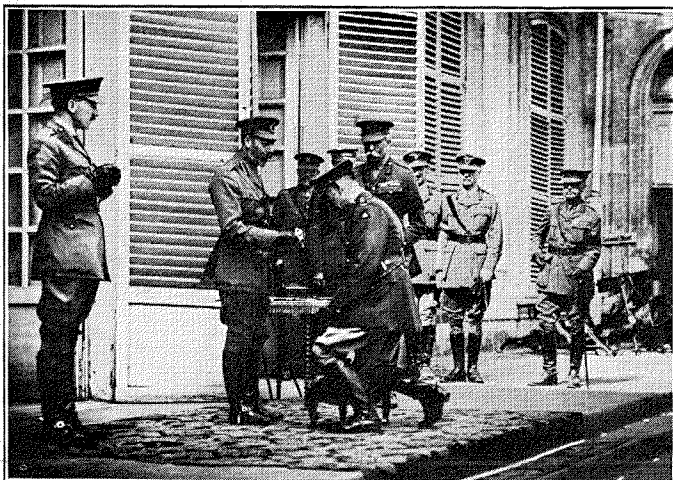


INCIDENTS IN THE MILITARY CAREER OF THE LATE SIR JOHN MONASH.

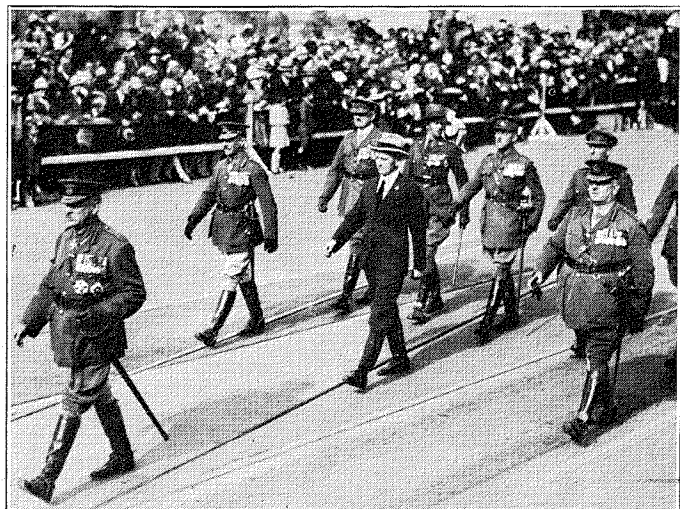

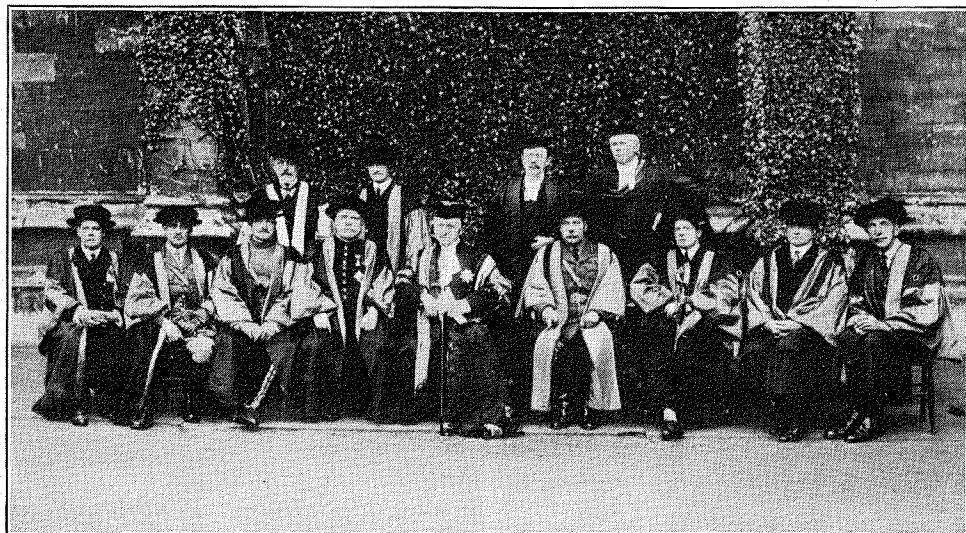
*Sir John Monash at the Head of the Anzac Day Column, passing over Prince's Bridge, Melbourne, 1930.*
